

# Crab Pot Set-up

Use only one Red/White buoy at this point. This is very necessary so that the floats do not lift the crab pot off of the bottom. If there is too much flotation at this point, the floats will make the pot jump around in reaction with the wave motion. If the pot jumps around, the crab that have entered the pot will leave. Adequately weight the pot so that it does not walk off into deeper water.
