

Point no Point/Skunk Bay

This is distinctly two very different fishing areas. Each area can be as good as the other. Skunk Bay is where the downrigger anglers hang out. Fish at Skunk Bay in 90-120 feet of water and hug the bottom.

Fishing near Point no Point is where the drift moochers do their fishing. This is one of the last areas in Puget Sound where drift mooching is still very popular. If you fish here with a downrigger, you will feel very out of place. Drift mooching is done with 2-6 ounces of lead and a cut-plug Herring. Let your line to the bottom and retrieve the bait slowly.
